Next Generation 9-1-1

S. Bremer and R. Zaleschuk provided a presentation regarding Next Generation of 9-1-1 (NG 9-1-1) communications technology, which has been initiated by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) to improve emergency communications in a growing wireless mobile society.

Staff confirmed for the board that NI 9-1-1 is well situated for Next Gen 911 and outlined the infrastructure already in place and the steps taken to prepare for the scheduled NG 9-1-1 launch in 2020. Staff also reviewed the 2020 timelines for equipment upgrades, testing and training as well as the capital improvements required to meet compliance by June 2023 and included in the 2020-2024 financial plan.
